The Palace of Versailles has been listed as a World Heritage Site for 30 years and is one of the greatest achievements in French 17th century art. Louis XIII's old hunting pavilion was transformed and extended by his son, Louis XIV, when he installed the Court and government there in 1682. A succession of kings continued to embellish the Palace up until the French Revolution.

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



Reims is a city in which history has given an exceptional heritage and background. The city offers many beautiful buildings which were used by the kings of France and are listed today as a Unesco World Heritage site : the Notre-Dame Cathedral, the Tau Palace, the former Saint Remi abbey which are visited daily by tourists from around the world.

factory (Veuve Clicquot)

On October 23, 1805, Barbe Nicole Clicquot, was 27 at the time of her husband's death, he bequeathed her a champagne house which had been created 33 years ago and which was producing 100,000 bottles annually. Nicknamed "the great lady of Champagne", she became the first woman to run a Champagne House and one of the first business women of the

modern era. When she died in 1866, the house sold 750,000 bottles and shipped its production to many countries.



### Directions from the airport :

#### **From Roissy :**

Take the RER B to Massy Palaiseau and stop at Saint Michel – Notre Dame.  
Then, take the RER C to Saint Quentin en Yvelines.  
You will have a train every 12 minutes.


#### **From Orly :**

Take ORLYVAL (9.30 EUR each way – Extra fee) to Antony.  
Then RER B to Roissy Charles de Gaulle Airport and stop at Saint Michel – Notre Dame.  
Then, take the RER C to Saint Quentin en Yvelines.


#### **From Gare du Nord :**

Take the RER B to Massy Palaiseau and stop at Saint Michel – Notre Dame.  
Then, take the RER C to Saint Quentin en Yvelines.  
You will have a train every 15 minutes.

## To go to Versailles on Wednesday :

You will take the train or the bus with the students guides.

**To return to Saint Quentin en Yvelines after visiting the Chateau de Versailles,** trains will pass by frequently at Versailles Chantiers station, so you will have many options. Make sure that the train goes to Saint Quentin en Yvelines.

## To go to Paris on Thursday :

Take the train N to Paris Montparnasse at **11:49**.

**To go to the Eiffel Tour from Montparnasse,** take the metro 6 to Charles de Gaulle Etoile and stop at Bir Hakeim.

**To return to Paris Montparnasse,** there are several metropolitan stations that you can choose from. There will be someone in each station that can assist you.

**To go to Saint Quentin en Yvelines,** take the train to Rambouillet and stop at Saint Quentin en Yvelines.
